Hiding God's Word deep within your heart is powerful! And each member of your family can start and find this to be a very worthwhile activity. This isn't ever to be about showing off. We want to apply and share God's Word to help people. And the Lord will richly bless Christians in this. Here are some tips:

- Don't over do it with family members ...so they quit forever. Be sensitive. Start with a reasonable number of verses. Don't push others and make them abhor such a wonderfully edifying exercise.
- Begin with single verses and gradually work up to more ..or even entire chapters. I know some Christians who memorize whole books – even the entire New Testament. But never grow proud of what you know.
- Please do not exclude young children from this great activity. Even 3 to 4 year olds can learn verses if you select the right ones. Don't underestimate them.
- Please be flexible according to the different learning abilities of the individual members of your family. It's ok to provide a challenge or attainable goals for those who are willing. Pray together for one another. Praise the Lord exuberantly as each attains some success from this type of study and memorization. Knowing and falling in love with the Person of Jesus Christ should be the aim. You all will reap if you faint not.
- If they children are young, you could post a fun chart to monitor each family member's progress. Older people can get excited about memorizing and reciting Bible verses too.
- I recommend you use the New King James or the King James Version for Bible memorization, for they are based upon the Received Text (Textus Receptus) and untainted by many deletions and the marks of modern textual criticism.
- Pray and Review, review, review the learned verses ...adding new ones. Christ can help you do this. Depend upon Him!

King James Bible Verses to Memorize

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

(v.38) This is the first and great commandment.

(v.39) And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

(v.40) On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

(v.1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

(v.2) The same was in the beginning with God.

(v.3) All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

John 1:29

The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 3:1-7

(v.1) There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

(v.2) The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

(v.3) Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

(v.4) Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

(v.5) Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

(v.6) That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

(v.7) Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

John 3:14-19

(v.14) And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:

(v.15) That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

(v.16) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should

not perish, but have everlasting life.

(v.17) For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

(v.18) He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

(v.19) And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

John 3:30

He must increase, but I must decrease.

John 3:36

He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

John 10:27-30

(v.27) My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

(v.28) And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

(v.29) My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

(v.30) I and my Father are one.

John 13:35

By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

John 14:1-6

(v.1) Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

(v.2) In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

(v.3) And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

(v.4) And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

(v.5) Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

(v.6) Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

John 20:30-31

(v.30) And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book:

(v.31) But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

Acts 4:12

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Romans 1:16

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 3:10-11

(v.10) As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

(v.11) There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.

Romans 3:23

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 5:1

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Romans 5:8

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Romans 10:9-10

(v.9) That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

(v.10) For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:17

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 12:1-2

(v.1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

(v.2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 12:19

Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

Romans 12:21

Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

1 Corinthians 1:18

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

1 Corinthians 3:11

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

(v.19) What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

(v.20) For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Corinthians 10:31

Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Galatians 2:20

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Galatians 6:7-9

(v.7) Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

(v.8) For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

(v.9) And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Ephesians 2:8-10

(v.8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

(v.9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

(v.10) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 4:29-32

(v.29) Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

(v.30) And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

(v.31) Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

(v.32) And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Ephesians 5:18-21

(v.18) And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

(v.19) Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

(v.20) Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

(v.21) Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Ephesians 6:1

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

Ephesians 6:10-11

(v.10) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

(v.11) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

Philippians 2:5-11

(v.5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

(v.6) Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

(v.7) But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

(v.8) And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the

death of the cross.

(v.9) Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

(v.10) That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

(v.11) And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 4:13

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Colossians 2:8-9

(v.8) Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.

(v.9) For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Colossians 3:1-2

(v.1) If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

(v.2) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

(v.13) But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

(v.14) For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

(v.15) For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

(v.16) For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

(v.17) Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

(v.18) Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-22

(v.16) Rejoice evermore.

(v.17) Pray without ceasing.

(v.18) In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

(v.19) Quench not the Spirit.

(v.20) Despise not prophesyings.

(v.21) Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

(v.22) Abstain from all appearance of evil.

1 Timothy 1:15

This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

1 Timothy 2:5

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

2 Timothy 2:15

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

2 Timothy 3:12

Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

2 Timothy 3:15-17

(v.15) And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

(v.16) All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

(v.17) That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 7:25

Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

James 1:22

But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
