



Christ is Trustworthy

"Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5-6

Faith is a vertical bridge of trust that you can have with the Lord—He is so trustworthy! We Christians must have complete confidence in God to take care of us, because this complete confidence will lead to constant compliance.

If He's worth part of your life, He's certainly worth all of it! What are you holding onto today? What in the world is holding you back from full commitment? Do you have any idols to forsake?

Will you humbly dethrone yourself and wisely enthrone Jesus as "Lord" in your heart? Why have Christ as Lord merely in theory, but not in practice or for real? Give it all to Christ. Instant obedience will bring down incredible blessings. We're in it for Him alone! Let your seeking, fishing and sowing bless a world!
